

August Guild Meeting

Presentation – 08/13/18, call to order 6:30pm

Welcome and Introductions – Joe Kobes

Introduction of representatives present holding board positions.

Principals Report – Assistant Principal Jennifer Perreault

- Storage area room was built and is now functional. This is located on the East Side of the gymnasium.
- After Cool Fitness – Take place Mon., Wed., and Friday's and will start on 08/20/18. The sessions will be called by the student's homeroom.
- Re-arrangement of the cafeteria to handle students sitting by homeroom
 - Handle dismissal of homeroom class more efficient for After Cool Fitness for K-4 grade
 - 42 new students in 1st through 4th grade, sitting by homeroom was to allow the new students an easier transition
 - Peanut free tables are now located at the end of each row
- Minor Incident Report (MIR) – New process to MTA, but is being used by other schools within the district.
 - This is not an office referral!
 - Tracked by the teachers to positively detract from the behavior. Provides a chance to turn the behavior around before getting to a referral

Treasurer's Report – Handout – Brigette Green

Budget was presented as the handout, this will be proposed for adoption from the Guild next month. This is a conservative budget due to the fundraiser rotation being the coin drive for this year, rather than the Fun Run.

- Kiln purchase was part of the capital improvement budget from last year's budget, there are still construction related costs that need to be paid to make the structure for the kiln safe.
- District is paying for the Kinder Aids
- Scholarship Fund - \$3,500 – Form needs to be emailed and is completely anonymous
- Teacher allotment – Question from parent on possibly increasing this. This currently handles \$100 allotment per teacher, and the District provides another \$250 per teacher. Discussion took place regarding the other opportunities that the Guild provides for teachers. Teachers supply closet has a budget item, along with the Teacher Purchases budget line item

- Expect to raise \$69,050 as part of the Coin Drive taking place on Family Fun Day

 - 85% of MTA Families pay the \$10 membership fee to make the goal
 - \$25 gives you a paper directory
 - Voting requires membership once the by-laws are complete

- Coin Drive – Start saving your pennies! Take place the week of Oct 29th to Nov 2nd. Goal is to raise \$15,000, which is an average of \$38 per MTA Family.
