



Expenses



The expenses for the Book Fair were offset by sales. Our School Librarian received credits from Scholastic that can be used to buy new books. The expenses for the Parent-Child dance were offset by ticket sales, and the generous donations of our MTA families and local business sponsors. The Guild ensured that all funds that were budgeted for teacher/staff appreciation were used to provide catered lunches/breakfasts and thank-you gifts for our staff.



Volunteering Requirement

- It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to seek out, schedule and complete their volunteer time.
- Per the Family Commitment Form, each family is required to volunteer a minimum of 20 hours per year.

- You are allowed a total of two months off, but are expected to work in some capacity for 8 of the 10 school months (Aug-May)
- CONSEQUENCE FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF YOUR OPEN ENROLLMENT STATUS.

Volunteering Requirement

- Volunteer Hours will be tracked through Raptor.
- You must have a Raptor Account to Volunteer
- Parents, Legal Guardians, and Grandparents are eligible to volunteer.
- Hours must be scheduled a head of time.
- On-Campus and At-Home Opportunities are available.
- Opportunities are provided by the Guild, Classroom and Special Area Teachers.

• Attendance at monthly Guild meetings are worth one hour of volunteer time, per family.

Raptor Instruction

- Technical issues are resolved ⁶⁹
- What is Raptor?
 - Per recommendations from the district, we will use Raptor to track volunteer hours this year. We will no longer use HelpCounter.

- Raptor will track volunteer hours when volunteers "clock in" and "clock out" at the Raptor kiosk in the front
 office when volunteering on campus. You must be pre-registered for Raptor to clock in as a volunteer on
 campus.
- Volunteer hours completed at home should be tracked and reported to your teacher or volunteer committee chair to enter manually
- While volunteer hours will be tracked through Raptor, event planning / volunteer shift signup process can be completed through Raptor or another platform such as signup genius.
- Volunteer shift opportunities will be announced weekly in the Hoots and Hollers emails, with links either to signup genius, or instructions on signing up through Raptor
